School supplies for a child for a year in Senegal



The Talibe Project provides the minimum level of supplies needed to execute an effective learning program. Writing boards, notebooks, and writing materials are essential for quality lessons and learning exercises.

Medical and hygiene care for a child in Cambodia for a year



A medical clinic and program ensure that children can receive basic hygiene and health services. The funds for this program cover the costs of the medical service center and a full-time nurse to attend to all beneficiary children at no cost to their families.

Schoolbooks for a child for a year in Senegal



The Talibe Project provides secular textbooks that are not otherwise available to the children, enabling nearly 584 children to work on reading comprehension and literacy skills.

A range of supplies are needed to effectively carry out the education of nearly 600 children, including books in Khmer and English, math books, notebooks, classroom materials, pens, markers, and pencils.

A child's yearlong participation in the mobile library literacy program



The Mobile Library provides access to books, reading, and art activities. For children who don't have access to books or encouragement at home, the library comes to them! Through dynamic and interactive classes, the Mobile Library (a truck filled with books) encourages a love of reading for 1,000 impoverished children in the most marginalized areas of Tegucigalpa.

A child's yearlong participation in the tutoring program in Honduras



Working in close partnership with the community, JustWorld serves children orphaned by HIV/AIDS, as well as other children with little family support, through several programs including a successful after-school tutoring program. Three full-time JustWorld tutors commit themselves to providing at least 110 children with the educational support they require in order to succeed in scholastic programs. These tutors cover a range of subjects with the students, including math, language, history, and geography.

Scholarship for a child to attend school for a year in Honduras

Angelworks is a scholarship program for rural Honduran school children with excellent academic standing. Currently the Angelworks program helps children from various villages outside the capital city including Tatumbula, El Chimbo, and Villa Vieja. Through this partnership, 250 children who would otherwise not be able to attend school are recipients of school supplies and uniforms that enable them to receive the education they deserve.

School supplies for a child for a year in Honduras

While school through grade six is technically "free" in Honduras, affording the necessary materials to attend school as well as participate in the tutoring program is often out of reach for many children in Tornabe. The JustWorld program provides supplies such as uniforms, books, notepads, pens, pencils, erasers, and dictionaries, thus allowing these children to attend school and enabling their effective learning.

Scholarship for a child to attend school for a year in Guatemala



In 2008, JustWorld began fundraising to provide children of Los Patojos with scholarship packages that cover the costs of necessary supplies such as school shoes, uniforms, notebooks, dictionaries and scholastic textbooks—items that many families cannot afford. These basic supplies make a significant difference in the quality of education these children receive. The pilot program included 40 children from the Los Patojos program selected on the basis of their academic excellence. The children in this program often come from families and communities whose daily lives are interrupted by violence. The children's achievements in school are helping to change the social conditions of these families and their communities. The high achievement results of these students proved how effective the scholarship packages are and, as a result, the program is expanding to 95 children in 2009–2010.

Daily lunch at school for a child for a year in Cambodia



The nutrition program is particularly important in our Cambodia project because the children at the PIO schools often have no other source of food for the day and are unable to learn successfully while hungry. The lunch program includes the salaries for a cook, an assistant cook, a cleaner, and a guard; utility costs of the kitchen as well as cooking and dining utensils; and costs of daily lunch consisting of rice, soup, vegetables, fish, and meat. The program also provides monthly rice allotments to parents as incentives for those who support regular school attendance. This rice allotment helps provide food for these children's families, thus reducing the need to send their children to gather food scraps or to earn money working in the dump. The cost of food has recently been on the rise, making this program increasingly difficult and important to continue.

Daily lunch for a child for a year in Guatemala



Also in 2009, JustWorld supported Los Patojos to create a community kitchen. The kitchen currently offers a lunch program for 70 children in extreme need and aims to ultimately provide meals for 250 children. Children cannot learn if they do not have access to nutritious and healthy food. The program also aims to educate children and their parents about how to prepare healthy meals at home and to teach the distinction between good and poor nutrition.
